Bio

Maria Kozak is a Polish-American painter living between upstate New York and Warsaw, Poland. She makes imagined, figurative landscapes that live outside time or space, ambiguous of identity. Her artworks are about unseen forces and the absurdity of being a human, the dark comedy and the parts of the unconscious mind that we try to hide or ignore. Her œuvre draws from German Expressionism, Surrealism, psychedelia and the transavantgarde.

Kozak (born 1981 in Cracow, Poland) has a Master's degree in painting from the New York Academy of Art and is an alumni of NEW INC, the New Museum's incubator for art + technology. She was awarded a NYFA/NYSCA Grant and a Schusterman Foundation Fellowship for her work in emerging technology.

Inspiration

Coming from a long line of dowsers, alchemists and Polish mystics, I believe in the interconnectedness of all things and our power to bend reality. My mother tested everything with her pendulum. I feel the energy strong in my palms. I try to capture this force both in subject matter and the physical process itself in an effort to make the unseen, seen.

Bio

Kinga Su is a multi-faceted multidisciplinary Polish artist living in Strasbourg, France. Within the vast tapestry of her creative expressions, animation emerges as the primary conduit through which she breathes life into images. Yet, her artistic yearning extends beyond the digital canvas; she ardently embraces the tactile dance with materials, through traditional graphic techniques such as linocut, drypoint, and woodcut.

Su was born in 1994 in Poland. Graduated from French Studies at the University of Warsaw and Graphic Arts at the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw, Poland. She is currently graduating from Graphic Communication at Haute École des Arts du Rhin in Strasbourg, France.

Inspiration

Whether it's digital or manual work, I always strive to contemplate and gain deeper insight into the issues that we are facing as humanity and bring them closer to the audience through a visual journey. I'm inspired by natural processes and materials, which I first need to learn how to work with and be guided by their qualities. This kind of work has a meditative quality for me, and I hope to bring that experience to the viewer, creating a very sensitive and intimate piece.
